The Synod for a Synodal Church

Last Sunday at the Vatican, Pope Francis opened the Synod of Bishops. A Synod is not an Ecclesiastical Parliament, it is a process of the people of God walking together in mutual respect for one another following a common cause or vision. The cause and vision of this Synod is YOU, the valued members of the Church, the pilgrim people of God. The topic of this synod is to discover what it means to be the Church in Leek in the twenty-first century. For Pope Francis there are three components to this Synod: first there is *communion*, when we value each other as brothers and sisters in Christ who are co-responsible for the life and mission of the Church; next there is *participation*, how we can, in our own situations, share our time, talent and treasure with each other in ways which enrich one another; and finally, *mission*, reaching out to those who do not know God and to those who have been disappointed by the Church. It is both a historic and an ambitious project with far reaching consequences. This weekend the Archbishop has sent a Pastoral Letter which will read at Mass about this Synod process.
