Dear friends, on Thursday evening, 10 parishioners accompanied me to the Opening Meeting of the Parish Visitation. During the meeting we were informed that Archbishop Bernard will be visiting St Mary's. He will be visiting the parish to meet you. You are his parishioners and it is right that you have the chance to meet with him. The Visitation is not an inspection.

Since the last Visitation in March 2018, there have been huge changes to our lives: the pandemic, the cost of living, the impact of the war in Ukraine, and how the media reports all of this to us. We are to provide the Archbishop with some key parish statistics and your responses to the Synodal Pathway. All of this will need to be in the context of a realistic look at future structures that are viable. You will know that there are fewer people coming to church for Mass and in a short time there will be less than 100 priests for the parishes in our Archdiocese. We will not be able to sustain our current practice too far into the future.

With this in mind, I am reminded of the Parable of the fig tree (Luke 9:6-9)

"Then he told this parable: "A man had a fig tree growing in his vineyard, and he went to look for fruit on it but did not find any. So he said to the man who took care of the vineyard, 'For three years now I've been coming to look for fruit on this fig tree and haven't found any. Cut it down! Why should it use up the soil?" "Sir,' the man replied, 'leave it alone for one more year, and I'll dig around it and fertilize it. If it bears fruit next year, fine! If not, then cut it down."

I need *your support*, friends! Let's be responsible for our part of the vineyard. Let's nurture it. Let's make it grow so I believe that we can reverse the trend. Let's be bold. Let's show that we want God in our lives. I want to encourage

that it will produce good fruit. you to these actions:

- Let's return to Mass I want to invite those who have not been to Mass since the beginning of the pandemic; those whose children will be
 receiving First Holy Communion and the Sacrament of Confirmation next year: let's support the children in the best way by bringing them
 to Mass!
- Let's return to the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
- · Let's set aside 5 minutes every day to pray.
- Let's share our time, talent and treasure.
