Dear friends, today, has been called *Evangelii Gaudium* Sunday. *Evangelii Gaudium* or the Joy of the Gospel was the title Pope Francis gave to his first Apostolic Exhortation following his election as Pope in 2013, it is a bright and attractive vision for the Church and Christian living.

As we keep *Evangelii Gaudium*, the Joy of the Gospel Sunday, we have been asked to consider how we are to mark next year, 2024, as the year of preparation for the Jubilee Year in 2025. For Pope Francis, he wants us to observe next year as a "great 'symphony' of prayer" based on the Lord's Prayer and to make it our programme of activity.

I would like us to have 7 prayer intentions, one intention for each day of the week. We can pray the Lord's Prayer for that intention and also apply our acts of self-denial to those 7 intentions. For me, the initial intentions I would like us to pray for are: the children and young people of our parish preparing for First Holy Communion and Confirmation; for the sick and housebound parishioners; and, for families.

Sacramental Preparation On Thursday afternoon, I met with the parents of those children who are due to receive First Holy Communion and Confirmation next summer. It was good to be together. I want us, the whole parish, to work together to encourage the children and young people who will receive the sacraments next year. They are being prepared for amazing opportunities: the children due to receive First Holy Communion will meet the Lord who makes the blind see, the deaf hear, forgives sinners, looks for and rescues the lost. Those due to be Confirmed will receive "power"; the Greek word for power is the same word which gives us the English word, "dynamite". Whey they are Confirmed, they will become like dynamite, they will be explosive and unstoppable. Please encourage the children and their families. Let's pray for them. Let's offer our acts of self denial that the gift of faith will grow strong for them.

Fr Hudson's Care working to improve the lives of Children across the Archdiocese. Our Family Support Service and New Routes Fostering Service work to improve the lives of children across the Archdiocese. The Family Support Service is based in schools to support families that are facing challenges that can impact a child's wellbeing and educational attainment. In the last year the challenges faced by families across the Archdiocese have become clear, our Family Support Service Crisis Fund has provided almost four times as many grants to families, overwhelmingly to purchase food to feed the family, while they receive the support they need to improve their situation and reduce the impact of crises on children. Children who cannot remain with their family of origin are offered temporary shelter, support, love and care through our New Routes Fostering Service. Our Foster Carers are supported every step of the way, by experienced and compassionate Social Workers and through regular training and guidance. Although children often have little control over their situation your support of our work means that they can receive the love and support they need to thrive in school and beyond.
