Dear friends. Please do support Pope Francis in your prayers this weekend as he in Mongolia. He is the first Pope to visit that country. Here are some statistics about the Catholic Church in Mongolia: 31 years since the first missionaries brought Catholicism to Mongolia, The first missionaries, members of the Congregation of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (CICM) or Scheutists, arrived in Mongolia in 1992. 1,500 The number of Catholics in Mongolia, according to Matteo Bruni, Director of the Holy See Press Office. As of November 31, 2022, the Pontifical Yearbook counted 1,394.Catholics represent around 0.04% of Mongolia's population, making it one of the countries with the fewest Catholics in the world.

63,600 The number of Christians in Mongolia. The majority are Protestants (36,100) and Evangelicals or associated groups (23,000). The Russian Orthodox Church numbers 2,650.Christians 63,600 The number of Christians in 54 The number of institutes run by the Catholic Church in Mongolia. Almost 50 — specifically 48 of them represent 2.1% of the Mongolian population, are charitable institutes for the poorest or most vulnerable populations, notably the disabled. Six are educational institutes. 6 The diocese currently has 6 seminarians. Some of them are studying in South Korea. 35 The number of baptisms in Mongolia in 2022, down as compared 2012 (69). According to several missionaries interviewed by I.MEDIA, the cause of this drop is to be found in the aggressive competition from certain Protestant and Evangelical churches, but above all in the advent of consumer society in Mongolia.

From 1 September until the 4 October, the Church marks the Season of Creation. This isn't a liturgical season, but a time to The Season of Creation raise awareness of our Chrisitan role to be stewards of creation. Pope Francis has sent a message for the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. This has been uploaded to the Parish Website and some copies are available at the back of the church.

It would be great to fill the church with families, children and young people; to see the connections made between the generations; and, that everyone is able to cultivate their Spiritual life by making Holy Moments and learning more about the brilliance of Catholicism.

New academic year The new school year will begin this week. It is now incredibly important that the parish and the schools work together more than ever before to ensure that the mission of both our Catholic Parish and our Catholic Schools continues. We cannot be complacent in the spiritual development of the children and young people. We have to work together! I do encourage you to pray for our schools, for the children and young people. Let's all work together to increase the number of children, young people and families at Mass in church. As Catholics, we belong at Mass! At the beginning of the new term, please do write a message of support to both Mrs Turner, the Principal at St Mary's, and to Mrs Waugh, the Principal at Painsley. At the beginning of the new academic year there are two important occasions:

Friday 8 September, the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary 10am Whole School Mass in church Saturday 9 September 615pm Family Mass for Education Sunday. It would be great to fill the church with families of children and young people from both St Mary's Academy and Painsley Catholic College.

Sacramental Preparation For 2024 The compulsory meeting for parents of those children in School Year 3 or School Year 6 at Saint Mary's Academy will take place at 4pm on Thursday 14 September and will take place in church. During this meeting, parents will be asked to provide details of their child's baptism by Friday 29 September, 2023. During the next academic year children preparing for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation will have to attend Mass in church on Sundays in four blocks of six consecutive weeks. Each child will receive their own Mass attendance and activity card; there is one activity card for each of the four blocks of six Sundays; there will be a short activity to be completed. At the end of the task, the Mass attendance and activity card will have be stamped by the priest. The four blocks of six weeks will coincide with the school term; holiday time will not be affected. There will be more about this in the parents' meeting on Thursday 14 September. Parents should be aware that Sacramental Preparation will take place in school on Thursdays beginning in January, 2024. Sacramental Preparation for Confirmation will take place during lunch time. Sacrament Preparation for First Holy Communion will take place after school. A register of attendance will be taken each week. I would also like to inform parents of children who will be starting school Year 3 in September that the parents of children aged 7 years old and over wishing to be Baptised must attend a course of instruction. If your child was baptised in another Ecclesial Community ie the Church of England your child can only be admitted to the Sacraments if they are aged 7 years or over, attend an additional course of instruction with their parents, and attend Mass every Sunday. Parents are asked to contact Fr Martin and attend Mass.
