**New Mass times for Parishes across the Staffordshire Moorlands** Following the Parish Visitation, consultation of the priests in the North Staffordshire Deanery and the permission of the Archbishop, it has been recommended that the Parish Priests of Alton, Cheadle and Leek, supply for each other when need arises. In order for this to happen, it will be necessary to make a new arrangement for time of Sunday Masses in each of the three parishes. This will take effect at the first weekend of September, 2 -3 September this year. The new arrangement will be: St John the Baptist, Alton Sunday Mass at 9am St Giles's, Cheadle Saturday evening at 4.30pm and Sunday morning at 10.30am St Thomas's, Tean Sunday evening at 5.30pm St Mary's, Leek Saturday evening at 6.15pm and Sunday morning at 10am. This new arrangement creates the possibility for two priests to celebrate Masses in the four churches. If one priest is absent another priest can celebrate two Vigil Masses on a Saturday: one in Cheadle, the other in Leek.

**Parish Finance Committee: summary of our July meeting** The Parish Finance Committee is required by the Church's Canon Law to assist the Parish Priest with the administration of the Parish. At present, there are five parishioners who are appointed by the Parish Priest to be members of the Finance Committee. These are some of the issues discussed at our July meeting:

*Gift Aid* – current donations made are comparable to pre Covid values despite 17 less donors. We encourage all UK tax payers to donate their offering to sign a Gift Aid declaration the parish receives an additional 25% for every £1 donated.

Loose cash small donations scheme known as GASDS - in the last year we received £1,273.

Planned Parish Expenditure - We are planning to restore the sanctuary with the original altar which was removed a number of years ago; replace double glazing in the presbytery to conserve heat.

Parish Maintenance: Sweep and Clean continues every month; there was a discussion about external management of the car park; volunteer hours for 2022 amounted to 2,448 hours.

Alternative heat source for church and presbytery: While this may not be possible for the church; we looking in to the installation of localised smart metres; the longevity of the current heating system in the church; and, other schemes.

*Fundraising:* Christmas Cards £3.50 for pack of 10 cards, Calendars – price to be decided; the Amazon wish list has proved very helpful, and we are grateful for the donations which have been made.

Grant for the Listed Places of Worship VAT scheme. In 2022, the grant that St. Mary's Church received from this scheme amounted to £17,456.10.

**Ecumenical Pilgrim Group** Last Sunday before our 10am Mass, we welcomed a small party of senior Church leaders in Staffordshire to St Mary's. They were taking part in a three day walking pilgrimage to the sites of the three Cistercian Abbeys of North Staffordshire. The Anglican Bishop of Lichfield was in the group and he has written to us:

**New academic year** The new school year will begin very soon. It is now incredibly important that the parish and the schools work together more than ever before to ensure that the mission of both our Catholic Parish and our Catholic Schools continues. We cannot be complacent in the spiritual development of the children and young people. We have to work together! I do encourage you to pray for our schools, for the children and young people. Let's all work together to increase the number of children, young people and families at Mass in church.

At the beginning of the new term, please do write a message of support to both Mrs Turner, the Principal at St Mary's, and to Mrs Waugh, the Principal at Painsley. At the beginning of the new academic year there are two important occasions:

Friday 8 September, the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary 10am Whole School Mass in church

Saturday 9 September 6.15pm Family Mass for Education Sunday

Sacramental Preparation The compulsory meeting for parents of those children in School Year 3 or School Year 6 at Saint Mary's Academy will take place at 4pm on Thursday 14 September and will take place in church. During this meeting, parents will be asked to provide details of their child's baptism by Friday 29 September, 2023. During the next academic year children preparing for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation will have to attend Mass in church on Sundays in four blocks of six consecutive weeks. Each child will receive their own Mass attendance and activity card; there is one activity card for each of the four blocks of six Sundays; there will be a short activity to be completed. At the end of the task, the Mass attendance and activity card will have to be stamped by the priest. The four blocks of six weeks will coincide with the school term; holiday time will not be affected. There will be more about this in the parents' meeting on Thursday 14 September. Parents should be aware that Sacramental Preparation will take place in school on Thursdays beginning in January, 2024. Sacramental Preparation for Confirmation will take place during lunch time. Sacrament Preparation for First Holy Communion will take place after school. A register of attendance will be taken each week. I would also like to inform parents of children who will be starting school Year 3 in September that the parents of children aged 7 years old and over wishing to be Baptised must attend a course of instruction. If your child was baptised in another Ecclesial Community ie the Church of England your child can only be admitted to the Sacraments if they are aged 7 years or over, attend an additional course of instruction with their parents, and attend Mass.
