Dear friends, following last week's announcement here are the details of the new arrangements for Sunday Mass.

New Mass times for Parishes across the Staffordshire Moorlands Following the Parish Visitation, consultation of the priests in the North Staffordshire Deanery and the permission of the Archbishop, it has been recommended that the Parish Priests of Alton, Cheadle and Leek, supply for each other when need arises. In order for this to happen, it will be necessary to make a new arrangement for time of Sunday Masses in each of the three parishes. This will take effect at the first weekend of September, 2-3 September this year. The new arrangement will be:

St John the Baptist, Alton Sunday Mass at 9am

St Giles's, Cheadle Saturday evening at 430pm and Sunday morning at 1030am

St Thomas's, Tean Sunday evening at 530pm

St Mary's, Leek Saturday evening at 615pm and Sunday morning at 10am

This new arrangement creates the possibility for two priests to celebrate Masses in the four churches if one priest is absent and enable one priest to celebrate two Vigil Masses on a Saturday; one in Cheadle, the other in Leek.

Let's encourage each other! Let's give courage to each other to be at Mass every Sunday, to go to Confession once a month, to pray for 5 minutes every day and to share our time, talent and treasure. Last year there were over 2000 hours of volunteering in our parish. Let's increase the number of children and young people with roles and responsibilities in church. It would be great to welcome new altar servers, readers and singers. I can arrange more training meetings for new altar servers; and, readers, don't have to read all the readings, they could read one of the readings or the bidding prayers at Mass. Let's pray for each other. Let's pray for an increase in Vocations to the Priesthood – there is an acute need for more priests in our parishes. If each parish of the 217 parishes in our diocese sent one man to the seminary there would be no need to cluster parishes or close churches. Please pray for your priests!

Thursday 31 August Parish Outing to Trentham There is a lot of interest in a parish outing to Trentham Gardens on Thursday 31 August. The coach will leave St Mary's at 10am and pick up at Trentham at 4pm. The cost of the coach is £17 per person. Please secure your place by signing the list at the back of the church and paying a £5 deposit.

The Synodal Church Since 2021, at the invitation of Pope Francis, you have been invited to be part of the Synod Process. It began with parish level discussion, then to diocesan, national and continental (for us, European) level. And every continent submitted its work. Remember, we are a universal Church. It would be very surprising if every part of the world expressed the same concerns and areas of interest. We continue with our parish priorities: encouraging the Sacrament of Reconciliation — Confession: this is celebrated in church on Saturday morning from 10am; the Confessional is now in use for this; or, alternatively, please be in contact if you want to go to Confession. During the week, I will be meeting the leaders of the St Mary's Scouts to discuss ways in which the young people can be part of our parish.

I want to increase the number of children taking part in Mass Children and young people have a central place in the story of Christ; there are over 30 events in the Gospels which include either Jesus as a child or another young person has a central role. Let's encourage the children and young people in our parish to take roles especially as Altar Servers, Readers and Singers.

Altar Servers I would like to invite those children in Year 3 who have recently made their First Holy Communion and any child in school Years 4 and above who have made their First Holy Communion to become Altar Servers. The ministry of the altar server helps both the priest and the people to take part in the celebration of Mass. To be an altar server requires being able to learn new skills, to adapt to new situations, to be part of a team and to give a good example to everyone in church. There are two meetings

The summer holiday has begun The long awaited summer holidays are now here! If you are having a holiday this year, I hope that you have a good break and rest. During this holiday period, let's remember not to forget God. Please do make sure that you can get to Sunday Mass and to make time for personal prayer.

Sacramental Preparation for 2024 The compulsory meeting for parents of those children in School Year 3 or School Year 6 at Saint Mary's Academy will take place at 4pm on Thursday 14 September and will take place in church. During this meeting, parents will be asked to provide details of their child's baptism by Friday 29 September, 2023. During the next academic year children preparing for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation will have to attend Mass in church on Sundays in four blocks of six consecutive weeks. Each child will receive their own Mass attendance and activity card; there is one activity card for each of the four blocks of six Sundays; there will be a short activity to be completed. At the end of the task, the Mass attendance and activity card will have be stamped by the priest. The four blocks of six weeks will coincide with the school term; holiday time will not be affected. There will be more about this in the parents' meeting on Thursday 14 September. Parents should be aware that Sacramental Preparation will take place in school on Thursdays beginning in January, 2024. Sacramental Preparation for Confirmation will take place during lunch time. Sacrament Preparation for First Holy Communion will take place after school. A register of attendance will be taken each week. I would also like to inform parents of children who will be starting school Year 3 in September that the parents of children aged 7 years old and over wishing to be Baptised must attend a course of instruction. If your child was baptised in another Ecclesial Community ie the Church of England your child can only be admitted to the Sacraments if they are aged 7 years or over, attend an additional course of instruction with their parents, and attend Mass every Sunday. Parents are asked to contact Fr Martin and attend Mass.
