Easter Duties The Church wants us to benefit from the spiritual effects of Christ's suffering and resurrection and calls us to go to Mass, receive Holy Communion and go to Confession during the period of Easter Season.

Let's pray for an increase in Vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life At the beginning of September, Filip will formally begin formation for the priesthood at the seminary at Valladolid, Spain. There are four strands to priestly formation. The second of these strands is Spiritual Formation: it's not all study! We are told, "The essential content of spiritual formation specifically leading toward the priesthood is well expressed in the Second Vatican Council's decree Optatam Totius: "Spiritual formation...should be conducted in such a way that the students may learn to live in intimate and unceasing union with God the Father through his Son Jesus Christ, in the Holy Spirit. Those who are to take on the likeness of Christ the priest by sacred ordination should form the habit of drawing close to him as friends in every detail of their lives. They should live his paschal mystery in such a way that they will know how to initiate into it the people committed to their charge. They should be taught to seek Christ in faithful meditation on the word of God and in active participation in the sacred mysteries of the Church, especially the Eucharist and the Divine Office, to seek him in the bishop by whom they are sent and in the people to whom they are sent, especially the poor, little children, the weak, sinners and unbelievers. With the confidence of sons they should love and reverence the most blessed Virgin Mary, who was given as a mother to the disciple by Jesus Christ as he was dying on the cross."" (Pastores Dabo Vobis, 45)

Let's support Filip with our prayer! Let's keep him supported by our generous prayer for him. Let's not stop praying for more priests. We should double our efforts and pray that another man from our parish will be willing and free to give himself to serve Christ and the Church.
