Dear friends, last Saturday (1 July), Bishop Stephen visited our parish and celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation for 13 of the young people in Year 6 at St Mary's Academy. In preparation to receive the Sacrament, the children undertook a course of instruction at School and were encouraged to be at Mass every Sunday. Now that they have been anointed it is important for all of us, families, school and parish to work together to ensure that the anointing they received remains vibrant and meaningful in their lives. The best way we can do this is to remember that we are anointed. We were anointed at Baptism, Confirmation, and I was anointed at Ordination. Let us be bold in the practise of faith, let's continue to

- Be at Mass every Sunday
- Go to Confession once each month

- Pray for 5 minutes every day
- · Share our time, talent and treasure

Archbishop Bernard invites you to the final meeting of the Parish Visitation and Mass. On Tuesday 18 July, at 7pm, the Archbishop will be at St Gregory's, Longton, for the final meeting of the Deanery Visitation. During this meeting we will hear the recommendations regarding the future of the Deanery. This is an important occasion for everyone in our parish. I do ask you to support this meeting and the celebration of Mass which will be celebrated; it would be good to have a good representation of parishioners, please.

Sacramental Preparation for 2024 The compulsory meeting for parents of those children in School Year 3 or School Year 6 at Saint Mary's Academy will take place at 4pm on Thursday 14 September and will take place in church. During this meeting, parents will be asked to provide details of their child's baptism by Friday 29 September, 2023.

During the next academic year children preparing for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation will have to attend Mass in church on Sundays in four blocks of six consecutive weeks. Each child will receive their own Mass attendance and activity card; there is one activity card for each of the four blocks of six Sundays; there will be a short activity to be completed. At the end of the task, the Mass attendance and activity card will have be stamped by the priest. The four blocks of six weeks will coincide with the school term; holiday time will not be affected. There will be more about this in the parents' meeting on Thursday 14 September.

Parents should be aware that Sacramental Preparation will take place in school on Thursdays beginning in January, 2024. Sacramental Preparation for Confirmation will take place during lunch time. Sacrament Preparation for First Holy Communion will take place after school. A register of attendance will be taken each week.

I would also like to inform parents of children who will be starting school Year 3 in September that the parents of children aged 7 years old and over wishing to be Baptised must attend a course of instruction. If your child was baptised in another Ecclesial Community ie the Church of England your child can only be admitted to the Sacraments if they are aged 7 years or over, attend an additional course of instruction with their parents, and attend Mass every Sunday. Parents are asked to contact Fr Martin and attend Mass.

Altar Servers I would like to invite those children in Year 3 who have recently made their First Holy Communion and any child in school Years 4 and above who has made their First Holy Communion to become Altar Servers. The ministry of the altar server helps both the priest and the people to take part in the celebration of Mass. To be an altar server requires being able to learn new skills, to adapt to new situations, to be part of a team and to give a good example to everyone in church.
